OTTAWA, October 27, 2016 – The First Nations Health Managers Association (FNHMA) is excited to announce that a transfer of credit articulation agreement has been reached with Athabasca University (AU). The agreement outlines the transfer of credits that can be awarded to an individual for the FNHMA, Certified First Nations Health Management Program (CFNHMP).

FNHMA Executive Director, Marion Crowe, CFNHM states “This is a landmark moment for FNHMA, as our members now have the opportunity to continue their education journey should they wish to do so. It feels wonderful to have this articulation agreement with Athabasca University that grants credits for the Certified First Nations Health Management Program.
